Dear Simon,

I am writing in relation to fuel prices at your main Superstore in Newbury (Hector's Way, RG14 5AB).

A number of my constituents have written to me over the last year raising the fact that petrol prices across the Newbury area were inexplicably higher than they were in neighbouring areas. As a result of this, I wrote to the Competition and Markets Authority (CMA) earlier this year to ask them to explore the issue of price differentials (and I have to add, potential price-fixing in certain parts of the country).

As you will no doubt be aware, the CMA published its final report on the <u>road fuel market study</u> in July 2023. Amongst their recommendations were a new statutory fuel finder scheme, which has been accepted by the Government. And whilst it is under construction, the CMA created its own <u>temporary fuel price data scheme</u> which I have utilised today.

I set out a snapshot of the findings in relation to Sainsbury's that my office has identified:

As you can see the prices in Newbury are between 6-8% than in two of our nearest neighbouring towns which is disappointing and a source of consistent concern to my constituents.

Earlier today the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero wrote to all fuel retailers reiterating your duty to deliver a fair price to consumers. I attach her letter for ease of reference.
